Eugene Bies, Mayor, called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

A motion was made by Hanson and seconded by Wittrock-Seidel to approve the minutes of the June 29, July 6, July 10 and July 13, 2010 council meetings. Bies, Winter, Hanson and Wittrock-Seidel voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by Winter and seconded by Hanson to adopt the USDA loan resolution. Bies, Winter, Hanson and Wittrock-Seidel voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried. This resolution is attached to these minutes.

The council discussed an abatement for Cornerstone and Subway. The council will proceed to gather preliminary information.

A motion was made by Wittrock-Seidel and seconded by Winter to introduce Ordinance #231.1 which is An Ordinance Regulating the Use of Golf Carts on City Streets. Bies, Winter, Hanson and Wittrock-Seidel voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

The council discussed the Midcontinent Cable TV franchise. It will be on the August 3 agenda.

A motion was made by Wittrock-Seidel and seconded by Winter to waive the 30 day comment period for the HRA TIF project and also to authorize a letter of support for the project. Bies, Winter, Hanson and Wittrock-Seidel voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

The council discussed a garage on the 7th Street alley.
