Chris Husby and Brad Lueders discussed an issue at the wastewater ponds. Total suspended solids are above allowable levels for discharge. Treatment may be necessary. Two methods of chemical treatment were discussed. Staff indicated the lower cost option, alum, should work. A motion was made by Maas and seconded by Oellien to approve the use of alum to treat the ponds, if necessary. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion as carried.
